How to write a factual recount

A **factual recount** is a type of writing where you retell what someone else did by telling only the facts.

In a *personal recount* you use personal pronouns such as *I* and *me* because you are retelling something that happened to you. This is called *writing in the first person*.

Example: \underline{I} ran back home to fetch \underline{my} shoes.

In a factual recount you write in the third person and you use personal pronouns such as he, she, her, him, his, it and they.

Example: Seeta ran back home to fetch <u>her</u> shoes.

In a factual recount you retell things in the order that they happened but you don't include any feelings or extra information. You just give the facts.

Read the factual recount below and the notes that give you more information about this kind of writing.

Include a title. Use the third

Use words such as then and next to show the order in which things happened.

How Nthabi made a cake

Nthabi baked a chocolate cake. She followed a recipe from a magazine. First she got all the ingredients. She put flour, eggs, cocoa powder, sugar, margarine and milk on the kitchen table.

Then Nthabi fetched the equipment she would need. She placed a mixing bowl, a sieve, a mixing spoon, a measuring jug and cake tins next to the ingredients. Next, Nthabi turned on the oven to 180 degrees. She checked that she had the oven on bake.

Nthabi measured 150 grams of flour into the bowl. She cut 80 grams of butter into small pieces and added them to the flour. She poured 220 grams of sugar and 50 grams of cocoa powder into the flour and butter. Next, Nthabi mixed all these ingredients together. After that, she added 125 ml of milk and two eggs to the mixture and stirred until it was smooth.

Once the cake batter was ready, Nthabi took some margarine and wiped the inside of the cake tin with it so that the cake wouldn't stick to the sides of the tin. When the oven was hot, Nthabi poured the mixture into the cake tin and put the tin in the oven.

After 40 minutes, Nthabi took her cake out of the oven.
