Synonyms

Synonyms are different words that mean the same thing or that have a similar meaning. If you use different synonyms for a word you can make your writing more interesting.

Examples: The children were <u>lucky</u>. The children were <u>fortunate</u>.

Riaad <u>ran</u> to the finish line. Riaad <u>sprinted</u> to the finish line.

Antonyms	5

Antonyms are words that have the opposite meaning to other words.

Examples: The sand was <u>hot</u>. The sea was <u>cold</u>.

The cat was <u>black</u>. The dog was <u>white</u>.

We form some antonyms by adding a **prefix** before a word. The prefixes *un-*, *dis-* and *im-* all mean "not".

Examples: The boy was <u>un</u>happy.

The prefix *un*- is added to the word *happy* to make an antonym.

It was <u>im</u>possible to lift the bookcase.

The prefix *im*- is added to the word *possible* to make an antonym.

The student was <u>dis</u>organised.

The prefix *dis*- is added to the word *organised* to make an antonym.
